if $N \equiv 0 \pmod{3}$ then $3^{N/3}$

 if $N \equiv 2$ then $2 \cdot 3^{(N-2)/3}$

Given a positive Integer N , partitioned into positive integers,

$$N = \sum_{1 \leq i \leq k} x_i,$$

what is the maximum value of the product

$$\prod_{1 \leq i \leq k} x_i ?$$
